### INTRODUCTION

The Book Fairies is a small nonprofit that collects new and gently used books and gets them into the hands of kids that wouldn't have access to them otherwise. They work primarily on Long Island, NY but they also have an overseas program to distribute books in Africa.

### SOLUTION

The Book Fairies needed an IT service provider with expertise to help optimize its environment.
